



Level 2 Update – September 2020

Following Covid -19 Alert Level 2 protocols, we will require all buyers and transport coordinators to enter and exit the site via the main entrance to the car park, and then head to the Registration Office to sign in, regardless of whether you hold a permanent number or not.

We would however, ask that only CCSL Staff, Livestock Company staff, Purchasers and Transport Company Coordinators carrying out business be allowed to enter the yard site and therefore NO Spectators, Visitors or Children to attend please. Vendors and transport drivers will obviously be able to unload or load stock at the loading ramps but will not be able to enter the site boundary, beyond the loading ramps. Could all vendors please advise their Livestock Company in advance of stock being delivered for sale.

We would also request that all persons attending the sales, to use the hand washing and hand sanitation facilities provided and to follow the social distancing guidelines, by maintaining of 2 metres distance between people at all times.

HOWEVER, we would ask people, who have experienced any symptoms such as a cough, a high temperature, shortness of breath, a sore throat, sneezing and runny nose or temporary loss of smell not to attend any sales, or if you have come into contact with a positive Coronavirus (Covid-19) case. If you have these symptoms, please telephone Healthline (for free) on 0800 358 5453 or your doctor immediately.

We also advise anyone who is considered to be in the 'at risk' categories, i.e. the elderly, and anyone with pre-existing or underlying health conditions not to attend sales.

If you can answer yes to either of the questions below, please DO NOT attend sales.
