Prime Lambs - 850

A mixed quality yarding of prime lambs had a sale that reflected the quality with good lambs selling to levels similar to recent weeks with poorer types easing.

Prime Ewes – 750

No very heavy ewes yarded this week to push the top per head price higher than \$220. The balance of ewes sold to similar levels as previous weeks. Heavy rams increased in value by \$10 to \$15 per head with more competition.

Store Lambs - 3000
