#### Prime Lambs - 1350

A good-sized yarding of Prime Lambs, the market held firm on previous sales. Some lighter Lambs showing the effect of the dry. There is still good competitions for the top end of Lambs.

Prime Ewes - 1500

Another full sale today in the Ewe pens. A strong market, the top end heavy Ewes softened but medium & lighter Ewes sold firm.

Large \$210 - \$260 Medium \$160 - \$185 Light \$125 - \$155

Store Lambs - 800

A medium sized yarding of Store Lambs offered today. The quality was mixed with the tops weighing 30-34kg making \$140 - \$155. Medium Lambs weighing 25-30kg made \$110 - \$130, and the smaller Lambs made \$60-90. The smaller Lambs were hard to sell, with good demand for more forward types.

The Prime Steers were slightly up this week, 480-650kg Steers made \$4.84 - \$4.97, the top price was made by TM Inch Ltd with 6 big Angus Steers weighing 628kg making \$4.97. The Heifers were also up on last week with good Heifers making \$4.68 - \$4.90, & Dairy Heifers making \$4.33 - \$4.67. The Deans Collective yarded 4 Angus Heifers and topped the Heifers at \$4.90. Bulls were also strong with a large, they made from \$4.20 - \$5.00, Cows ranged from \$3.42 - \$3.88.
