Prime Lambs - 1200

A solid yarding of heavy, well-finished lambs is always a good sign, and from what's coming through the saleyard reports, the market's holding strong.

Large \$260 - \$313 Medium \$220 - \$260 Small \$190 - \$220

Prime Ewes - 200

A very mixed line up of Ewes today, saw prices slightly stronger than last week. Rams were \$160.

Large \$180 - \$200 Medium \$150 - \$180 Light \$100 - \$140

Store Lambs - 1200

A good-sized yarding of quality Store Lambs today at Coalgate, was met with good demand. A feature line of Rom Tex Ewe Lambs from The Lakes Station were very sought after, making \$192 - \$208. Fine wool Lambs made \$130 - \$180. The balance of Romney x Lambs made \$150 - \$190.

Prime & Store Cattle

A tidy yarding of prime cattle today with some standout lines of steers and heifers. The best steers reached \$4.92/kg, showing strong buyer interest for well-finished stock. Heifers followed closely at \$4.85/kg, with good quality throughout.

Cow numbers were light, so not much movement there. Prime Bulls made up to \$4.86/kg, which held firm considering recent trends. Overall, a good result with steady demand across the board. Buyers were selective but willing to pay for quality, especially anything with weight and finish.

A good yarding of quality Angus & Angus x Yearling Steers & Heifers were yarded today. There was very good demand from Central & North Canterbury buyers. Castle Ridge Station had 70 Yearling Angus Heifers that made \$1360 - \$1400 & Marble Point Station yarded 70 Yearling Angus Heifers that made \$1190 - \$1280.
