Prime & Store Cattle

Mixed quality in the Prime Steers seemed to sell very well. A single Simmental Steer at 700 kg topped the sale at \$3.98kg - \$2786. Tidy Steers were \$3.85 - \$3.55kg & forward Stores were 460 - 520kg made between \$3.70 - \$3.80kg.

Some quality Angus Heifers from Peak Hill Station at 554kg sold for \$3.96 making \$2193. Other good Speckle Park Friesian x Heifers at 530kg made \$2014. The Heifer market found a good rhythm with the Cattle being consistently well finished & buyers wanted them, they ranged from \$3.80 - 3.88, lighter trade Heifers were \$3.70 - \$3.78.

Beef Cows had a pretty good sale, heavy Angus Cows at 734 kgs made \$2.97 = \$2180, Other Hereford Angus x Cows at 610kg made \$3.05 = \$1860. Dairy Cows lifted to \$2.42 - \$2.60.

Store Cattle were in demand. AD Angus Cows PTIC to Angus Bull made \$1710 at 550kg. R2 Angus Heifers 400 - 432kgs made \$1540 - \$1650.
