Prime Lambs - 2150

A good-sized yarding of prime lambs was met with strong demand. Top lambs sold up to \$362 per head. Prices were up \$10 per head on last week's values with strong meat schedules increasing.

Prime Ewes - 500

Medium yarding with a strong sale for medium to good types.

Tops \$300 - \$363 Good \$240 - \$295 Mediums \$170 - \$235 Light \$115 - \$165

Store Sheep - 200

Smallest yarding of store lambs for the year with quality mixed. Shorter term lambs still met with some demand.

Several lines of ewes with lambs at foot sold on par with recent weeks. Good interest for smaller lines.

Some quality beef bred cattle yarded.

The heaviest steers made \$2435 per head.

Hereford/Friesian x steers at 729kgs made \$3.34 per kg.

Charolais x steers at 568kgs made \$3.37 per kg - \$1914 per head.

Angus/Friesian x steers at 604kgs made \$3.36 per kg - \$2029 per head.

Hereford/Angus x steers at 542kgs made \$3.38 per kg - \$1832 per head.

Heifers made from \$3.20 to \$3.36 per kg for quality beef bred.

Hereford/Friesian x types made from \$3.10 to \$3.20 per kg.
