#### Prime Lambs – 1390

A good larger yarding of Prime Lambs on offer today at Coalgate, with heavier Lambs on offer, which brought per head prices up. The market lifting along with the Schedule.

#### Prime & Store Cattle

Prime Steers sold very well today, lifting 15c/kg on previous weeks with multiple lines making over \$4.00/kg and the top price being \$4.10 for PT & JA Stephens for their 670kg Charolais Steers.

Prime Heifers were 5c/kg up on better quality, with most lines making \$3.70 - \$4.02. Topping the Heifer section for the sale was TR & RA Fergusons 5 Angus Heifers at 494kg making \$4.11c/kg.

A smaller yarding of Cows this week, but good quality was on offer, all cows lifted with Beef Cows making \$3.10 - \$3.18 and Dairy Cows \$2.77 - \$2.88.

With Bull season upon us it seemed everyone was having a clean out, which was met with strong demand. Sire Bulls 820 – 1010 kg making \$3.10 - \$3.22, Lighter Bulls made \$3.30 - \$3.85.

A smaller yarding of Stores with mixed quality was still met with strong demand.
