Prime Lambs – 2775

Biggest yarding of prime lambs was met with good demand with the top end not quite reaching the highs of last week. Medium lambs had a very good sale.

Prime Ewes – 550

After last week's very strong mutton sale, prices eased slightly by \$5 to \$10 per head.

Smaller yarding of store lambs/ewe lambs all counted were met with good demand, quality a bit mixed. Best shorn hoggets sold for \$150 per head.

Another large yarding of prime cattle.

A very tidy pen of Charolais/Simmental heifers at 523kgs sold for \$3.36 per kg.
