#### **Prime Lambs**

A small yarding today, with some very heavy Lambs on offer. The market was firm.

A small number of Ewes in the yards today. Premiums were pad for 1 Shear Rams & shorn, medium sized Ewes.

A small yarding of Store Lambs offered today. Good types sold well with good competition on a good line from Spye Farming – Omihi making up to \$193.

#### **Prime & Store Cattle**

Prime Steers of all weight ranges were in demand. Well finished Steers sold for \$5.10 - \$5.18kg. Lynchris farm topped the market at \$3653.30 per head, 708kg Steers at \$5.16. Prime Heifers 460-520 kgs were \$4.90 - \$5.00. Prime Dairy Heifers 460-510 kgs were \$4.68 - \$4.76. Prime Bulls had a substantial lift, 1 Angus Bull at 715kg made \$4.50kg = \$3217.50, 2 Charolais Bulls at 750kg made \$4.38 = \$3285.

In the Store pens the R2 Steers were mixed quality, HF x & AF x 330 – 425kg mace \$1350 - \$1930. A quality line of R2 Angus & AH x Heifers from CM & MA Dalzell, made \$1930 - \$2050 weighing \$400 – 429kgs. HF x Heifers made \$4.57 - \$4.71kg. DF & NJ Bowler sold a pen of yearling Shorthorn Steers at 403kgs for \$1950. Yearling HF x Heifers traded at \$4.50 - \$4.70kg, with some well-marked lines making \$5.00kg.
