A light yarding on numbers, but here was some very nice quality Prime Cattle. Dampier Crossley Family Trust, Rotherham kicked off the Steers, with six lovely quality Hereford Angus x Steers at 553 – 582kg making \$4.22 - \$4.26ckg. RA & L Stewart, Leeston sold 11 tidy Hereford Friesian x Steers at 505 – 562kg for \$4.10 - \$4.24ckg. SJ & SJ Dennis, Glenroy had five Hereford Friesian x Heifers at 512kg making \$4.18ckg, F & R McCallum, Rolleston had 6 Hereford Friesian x Heifers at 513 kgs making \$4.20ckg. Beef Cows sold from \$3.10 - \$3.20ckg, Leaner Beef Bulls made \$3.60 - \$3.80ckg, Beef Bulls with good condition made \$3.90 - \$4.00 & the Hereford Sire bull made \$3.22ckg at 865kg.
